Recently the Northam Knit & Natter group have been given several hundred beautiful, colourful blanket squares, some crocheted and some knitted. One blanket is already finished and a second is being assembled. When the project is complete, the blankets will go to

Christian Hope International, a charity based in Harold Wood, Essex which we have been working with for several years. From there they will go either to Moldova, where there is great poverty, or to the refugee camps in Jordan which are helping people fleeing Isis violence in Iraq.



In both locations, blankets and garments produced with love here in North Devon are saving lives.

Knitters from Holy Trinity, Westward Ho! & St Margaret's, Northam have knitted garments for charitable organisations over the years. Tiny bonnets & cardigans for premature babies at North Devon District Hospital; colourful sweaters for children in Eastern Europe; teddies & novelties for the Shoebox project which sends boxes of small gifts to children world-wide, and squares for 'comfort blankets' for women & children fleeing from domestic violence in the UK and support by Refuge.



These items are counted as 'life-savers', bring delight to children in war torn places, and remind adults & children alike that someone, somewhere cares." Many of the knitters belong to the 'Knit & Natter' Group which meets on the first & third Wednesday afternoon of the month at St Margaret's Church in Northam. Open to all, knitting & sewing from beginners and across the range, and of course nattering is crucial!
